We are sending this information to parents, so you are aware of what the children are going to be learning about this term. We are sending this information out in case we are forced into some form of school closure where blended learning will need to take place. The work can easily be completed at home and uploaded to the Google Classroom. Your children will be able to log in to Hwb using any digital device that connects to the Internet. Your child has been using Google Classroom in school to complete tasks, so they should be familiar with how to access the work for their group and how to submit their work.

This term the children in Dosbarth Bwncath have chosen to learn about 'Pirates' and have named the topic 'Guardians of Gold'. The children have thought about what they want to learn, and we have put these plans into place. The purpose of this leaflet is to inform you, as parents, what we are planning to cover if we are forced into a 'blended learning situation'.



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Creative	Science & Technology
<p>Lesson 1 - The children will be learning about the artist Pablo Picasso. Use the links in Google Classroom (Creative folder) to find out about the artist and create an information sheet about his life on plain paper. This can then be uploaded to Google Classroom.</p>	<p>Lesson 1 - The children will be finding out what light is and how we can see. Find some light sources and take a photo to upload to your Google Classroom. Talk about what it would be like not to have these sources. Find out how we see by following the links in the Science & Technology folder in Google Classroom.</p>
<p>Lesson 2 - The children will be using water colours (or ordinary poster paint) to paint over a Pablo Picasso black and white image. These can be downloaded from Google Classroom (Creative folder) to print out or collected from school.</p>	<p>Lesson 2 - The children will be learning about sound and how we hear. Find some items that make sounds and take a photo to upload to google Classroom. Talk about the different types of sounds. Find out how we hear by following the links in the Science & Technology folder in Google Classroom.</p>
<p>Lesson 3 - The children will be learning how to draw facial features in the style of Pablo Picasso. They will practice first on paper. Then they will draw them onto cardboard. They will colour these with paint or coloured pencils. A YouTube tutorial will be available on Google Classroom in the Creative folder.</p>	<p>Lesson 3 - The children will be learning about shadows and how they are created. They will create shadow art pictures and investigate how the length of a shadow changes throughout the day. The link to this can be found in the Science & Technology folder in Google Classroom.</p>
<p>Lesson 4 - The children will make a head shape for their Pablo Picasso portrait using cardboard. They will then assemble the facial features in the style of Picasso and finish painting or colouring.</p>	<p>Lesson 4 - The children will be learning how to use Adobe Spark (found on Hwb) to create a slide show.</p>
<p>Lesson 5 - The children will be evaluating their work using a frame (this will be on Google Classroom) and talking about what worked well and what they would improve. This can be completed using Goggle Classroom or on paper.</p>	<p>Lesson 5 - The children will be using Adobe Spark (found on Hwb) to create a slide show using the lyrics to a traditional Christmas carol.</p>



Humanities

Lesson 1 - The children will be learning about Spain. They will locate Spain on a map and think about the other places that share its border. They will locate the capital city on a map and will mark other significant places. They will talk about what they know about Spain and will generate questions to find out more about the country.

Lesson 2 - The children will diamond rank their questions and think about the most important ones to help them learn more about the country. They will have at least 6 questions to research. They will research each question and write their answers in their language books or on paper.

Lesson 3 - The children will continue with their research and will collect appropriate images such as, a flag, landmarks, traditional clothes. These will then be used in their information sheet. The children will either cut and stick these into their Topic Books or they will draw them themselves.

Lesson 4 - The children will share a good example of an information sheet. This will be available to see on Google Classroom in the Humanities folder. They will create a Success Criteria and will use this to begin to present their research as an information sheet.

Lesson 5 - The children will continue to create their information sheet and will share their work with each other. They will peer assess the work using the Success Criteria. This work will be uploaded to Google Classroom.

Health & Well-being

Lesson 1 - What is kindness? The children will think of a time someone was kind to them. What happened? What did they do? What do they think? How did they feel? Draw or write about it and share examples, highlighting how kindness can take many different forms. Next the children will draw an outline of their hand on a piece of paper. On each finger they can write or draw an idea of how to be kind to other people and upload to Hwb.

Lesson 2 - The children will have a piece of paper with two circles on it. In the first circle, they will draw how they feel when they are hungry and in the second circle, they'll draw how they feel when they've had a big, tasty meal. Discuss What was different about the faces? Why? Discuss food which helps us feel happy and healthy in our minds as well as our bodies.

Lesson 3 - The children will be making home made humous and trying this with some flat bread. Recipes and instructions will be in the Health & Wellbeing folder on Google Classroom.

Lesson 4 - Children will be taking part in Yoga exercises. The link will be in the Health & Wellbeing folder on Google Classroom.

Lesson 5 - Children will be taking part in dance exercises. The link will be in the Health & Wellbeing folder on Google Classroom.



We are hopeful that the school will remain open but in case the school, or our class, are forced to isolate we hope this information will help you to support your child at home. The activities are there to support home learning. We appreciate that you may not have all the resources but try and be imaginative and creative.
